Guidelines on infection prevention

<< About infection control measures>>

1. Operate in compliance with “Hokkaido University Hospital Infection Prevention Measures Guidelines for COVID-19”.
2. The participants should wear masks and refrain from talking in the venue as much as possible.
3. Reduced the number of seats in the auditorium (complying with 50% of the capacity).
4. A thermal camera will be installed at the entrance of the venue to check the body temperature of visitors.
5. Installation of alcohol disinfectant in various parts of the venue.
6. Regular disinfection of areas frequently touched by participants.
7. Ventilate the entire venue.
8. The staff must also wear a mask, and those who fall under the following are not engaged.
 - A) People with fever symptoms with body temperature above 37.5 ° C.
 - B) People with symptoms such as cough and sore throat.
 - C) Persons who have traveled to a country / region where entry restrictions and observation periods after entry are required by the government within the past 14 days, and persons who have close contact with residents of that country / region.
 - D) People who have had a medical examination or taken medication due to fever or cold symptoms within the past 2 weeks, and those who have contact with people who have similar symptoms within the past 2 weeks
 - E) Those who are not the above-mentioned persons but are concerned about suspicion of COVID-19 infection.
9. Please refrain from eating and drinking in the auditorium and the 1st meeting room except for hydration.

<< Request to participants>> Please be sure to read it.

1. Those who fall under A) to E) in 8. above will be refused admission.
2. When entering the venue, be sure to disinfect your fingers and have the temperature measured.
3. Please avoid wearing urethane masks and cloth masks only, and wear non-woven or better quality masks at the venue.
4. Please be sure to sit down and listen to the lecture to avoid crowding.
5. If the infection becomes clear (or if you become a close contact person), please cooperate in conducting an infection follow-up survey at a health center, etc.
6. If you feel any change in your physical condition, please do not overdo it and let us know as soon as possible.
7. When viewing the exhibition, please keep a sufficient distance between people.

We have prepared a hand disinfectant solution, but we recommend that you prepare a portable hand disinfectant yourself.

Please cooperate in thorough self-management in infection control.
